

Daniel R. Melamed is Professor at the Indiana University Jacobs School of Music. He is the author of *Hearing Bach's Passions* (updated paperback 2016) and *J.S. Bach and the German Motet*, co-author (with Michael Marissen) of *An Introduction to Bach Studies*, and editor of the essay collections *Bach Studies 2* and *J. S. Bach and the Oratorio Tradition* (Bach Perspectives 8). He has published articles on Bach, the Bach family, and Mozart opera, and edited musical works from the 17th and 18th centuries. He has served as editor of the *Journal of Musicology* and as vice president of the American Bach Society, and is now that society's General Editor.
